

Jacques Cousteau famously proclaimed the emerald waters of British Columbia as "the best temperate water diving in the world and second only to the Red Sea". British Columbia is chosen as one of the top diving destinations in North America year after year. The diversity of life, the health of the marine environment, and the breathtaking topside attractions make it a popular destination for scuba divers.

Hornby Island is located a couple hours north of Nanaimo or about an hour south of Comox, including required ferry rides. You can expect to see wolf eels, Pacific red octopus, jellyfish, as well as a plethora of rock fish, sea stars, sea cucumbers, crabs, colorful anemones, lingcod, sculpin, and many more. If you're lucky, you may even get buzzed underwater by a curious seal or sealion. Watch for the elusive six-gill shark that is not a danger to humans, but is a shy creature of the deep that sometimes frequents the shallow waters.

On the surface, keep your eyes out for orcas, seals, sealions, porpoises, and other small mammals that make these waters their home.

The Lodge

Hornby Island Diving is located on two acres of property at picturesque Ford Cove. The dive boat is moored just steps from the lodge. Dive sites are located within 15 minutes of the harbour.

Getting to Hornby Island:

By Air:

- Fly into Comox airport. Travel by car or floatplane to Ford Cove
- By Car:
 - Get to Vancouver Island via Tsawwassen or Horseshoe Bay ferries
 - Travel to Buckley Bay (about 1 hour north of Nanaimo or 30 minutes south of Comox)
 - Buckley Bay to Denman Island (about 10 minute ferry ride)
 - Gravellly Bay to Hornby Island (about 10 minute ferry ride)

The Boat
The dive boat was custom fabricated and divers love it. 35' length aluminum hull, forward cab and covered area, tank racks with seating (accommodates twins and rebreathers), stable ladder
