

Bonaire is known as the Caribbean's diving and snorkeling paradise. It is a small island located off the coast of Venezuela next to Aruba and Curacao and is part of the Netherlands. Bonaire is known around the world for its healthy and abundant marine life and was one of the first islands to distinguish its precious reefs as a protected marine park. Weather conditions are very consistent throughout the year and a tradewind sweeps across the island almost relentlessly providing a gentle breeze throughout the warm days and nights. Water temperature is warm ranging from high seventies to low eighties fahrenheit.

The diving is about as easy and laid-back as you will find anywhere in the world. Because the reef is only a couple minutes swim off the beach, shore diving is the most popular way to enjoy the underwater world. The road is lined with yellow-painted rocks that indicate the name of the dive site. Drive onto the beach that is covered with old broken dead coral rock, grab your gear, and go! Diving is 24 hours a day... get up early or sleep in, go for a night dive.... it's all up to you.

Although diving and snorkeling are the most popular activities on the island, there are a lot of other things for people to do and see. There is windsurfing, kayaking, beaches, yachting, birding, and sight-seeing. The Washington-Slagbaai National Park offers a variety of vegetation, animals, and birds including flamingoes, wild donkeys, and goats. The two main cities are Kralendijk (pronounced crawl-in-dike) and Rincon and both offer a glimpse into the Bonairian culture. Lots of great restaurants are found around every corner, very reasonably priced. Large selection at grocery stores is also available for dining in.

Perla Boneriano

This small, quiet resort is located in the midst of all the popular shore-diving and snorkeling sites. Head north or south and you'll have a tough time deciding which site is your favourite.

Within a half block walk are lots of retail outlets including a gift shop, drug store, liquor store, bank, fitness facility including massage, and the infamous Lovers Ice Cream parlour.

Each villa at Perla Boneriano includes 2 bedroom & 2.5 bathrooms, fully-equipped kitchens, covered patios, air-conditioning, TV & internet, outdoor shower, and gear rinse station. A couple of smaller 1-bedroom villas are available if desired.

The villas surround a swimming pool that is perfect for cooling off after a hot day of diving or for lounging around with a good book.

There is a small beach located within a short walk which is great for lounging around, snorkeling, or diving.

Dive shops are located.... everywhere making access to air or nitrox tanks a breeze. Rental gear is available but usually very expensive so bringing all essential gear with you is recommended.

Because the villas are fully furnished with kitchen essentials, eating in is easy to do. Grocery stores are fully stocked with high quality meats, canned & dry goods, fresh fruit & vegetables. There are many restaurant options as well and meals are priced similar to here, but the portions and quality seem a lot bigger and better.
